6:00 p.m. Friday to 6:00 p.m. Sunday.

SPRING BREAK- The non-custodial parent has visitation at least one-half of the Spring break

holiday every year.

EASTER AND 4<sup>TH</sup> OF JULY- Parents will alternate these two holidays.

THANKSGIVING- The non-custodial parent has visitation every Thanksgiving from 4:00 p.m.

Thanksgiving Day to 6:00 p.m., on Friday. If the regular visitation weekend

falls on this weekend, then visitation will be until 6:00 p.m. Sunday.

CHRISTMAS- The non-custodial parent has visitation from 4:00 p.m. on Christmas Day
