VISITATION SCHEDULE

- MOTHER- Every Mother's Day
6:00 p.m. Saturday to 6:00 p.m. Sunday
- FATHER- Every Father's Day
6:00 p.m. Saturday to 6:00 p.m. Sunday
- WEEKEND VISITATION- The non-custodial parent has visitation every other weekend from
6:00 p.m. Friday to 6:00 p.m. Sunday.
- SPRING BREAK- The non-custodial parent has visitation at least one-half of the Spring break
holiday every year.
- EASTER AND 4TH OF JULY- Parents will alternate these two holidays.
- THANKSGIVING- The non-custodial parent has visitation every Thanksgiving from 4:00 p.m.
Thanksgiving Day to 6:00 p.m., on Friday. If the regular visitation weekend
falls on this weekend, then visitation will be until 6:00 p.m. Sunday.
- CHRISTMAS- The non-custodial parent has visitation from 4:00 p.m. on Christmas Day
until 6:00 p.m. on the day before school resumes.
- BIRTHDAY: The non-custodial parent has visitation with the child for three hours on the
child's birthday.
- SUMMER: The non-custodial parent has Summer visitation for five weeks during the
Summer months. June- the second and fourth weeks. July- the second and
fourth weeks. August- the first week.
